PURPOSE AND INTENT

To establish a policy outlining the procedures and requirements for the provision of a utility service to a property situated outside of the boundaries of the Town of Chestermere.

POLICY

Service Connections


A property owner wishing to connect to a utility service, owned by and installed for the purpose of servicing the Town of Chestermere, in which the proposed property for servicing is located outside the boundaries of the Town must first make application to their governing agency, that being their local municipality where the property is located.

The completed application must contain all required details and any provisions required by third party professionals. The application will then be submitted by the municipality, on behalf of the property owner, to The Town of Chestermere for consideration. Final approval for allowing the service must be given by the Council for the Town of Chestermere.
