## Proclamation Green Shirt Day April 7, 2019

Green Shirt Day is a movement to bring awareness to organ donation and to honour the memory of Logan Boulet, one of the Humboldt Broncos players killed in a bus and semi-trailer crash on April 5, 2018. His wish to donate his organs was honoured, and his selfless act saved six other lives. This act inspired the largest number of Canadians registering to become organ donors, a movement known as the Logan Boulet Effect.

**WHEREAS:** organ donation can save lives and only 23% of Canadians have registered as donors;

**WHEREAS:** over 100,000 Canadians registered to become organ donors following Logan Boulet's organ donation 'gift of a lifetime';

**WHEREAS:** on Green Shirt Day, residents of Chestermere are encouraged to have conversations about organ donation and register to become organ donors;

**NOW THEREFORE,** I, Marshall Chalmers, Mayor of the City of Chestermere, do hereby proclaim **April 7, 2019** as **Green Shirt Day** in the City of Chestermere.
