AS OF MARCH 25, ALL CANADIANS ARE **LEGALLY** REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THESE PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS



IF YOU HAVE A COVID-19 SYMPTOM THAT IS NOT RELATED TO A PRE-EXISTING HEALTH CONDITION

You are required to self-isolate for 10 days.
COVID-19 symptoms include:



FEVER



DIFFICULTY
BREATHING



COUGH



IF YOU HAVE RECENTLY RETURNED FROM TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF CANADA OR ARE A CLOSE CONTACT OF SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

You are ordered into mandatory quarantine as per Federal law (*The Quarantine Act*). In this case, as soon as you return to Canada, you must go directly home. Do not stop for groceries or visit any family, friends, etc. Plan to have necessities dropped off at your home.



If you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, **stay at home** and use the self-assessment tool available at alberta.ca/COVID19 or call 8-1-1 to help determine whether you should be tested.
