



Business Re-Opening Steps

The Provincial Government has announced that [certain businesses may reopen during phases of the re-opening plan](#) but that they will be subject to increased sanitation measures.

Here are the recommended steps for you to take to reopen your business:

1. Check the [Provincial website](#) to find out when your business type may reopen.
2. Check with your head office or professional association to see if they have any guidelines around re-opening procedures.
3. Read the provincial [Workplace Guidance for Business Owners](#).
4. Read the Chestermere Emergency Management [Business Orders](#) and [Chestermere Business Re-opening Guidelines](#).
5. Collect your required cleaning, sanitation and personal protective equipment. More info about [Infection Prevention & Control](#) is available here.
6. Choose a re-opening date (it can be after the date the provincial government says you can reopen).
7. Events are not permitted but if you are planning to do anything special for reopening, you must create an enhanced health and safety plan and submit it for approval to the Emergency Command Centre by emailing ecc.liaison@chestermere.ca.
8. Advertise your re-opening date. Email ecc.liaison@chestermere.ca to have your business listing changed to 'open' on the City's website map.
9. Once you have re-opened, email ecc.liaison@chestermere.ca if you have any suspected cases of COVID-19 among your staff.
