

# Instructions for Referendum Ballots (Alternative Voting Equipment)

**Ballot requirements are established by Section 5 of the *Referendum (General) Regulation*.**

**For the ballot, the following requirements must be met:**

- The name of the event must be given
- Instructions must be given on how to properly mark the ballot

**2021 REFERENDUM VOTE**  
To vote, mark one circle per question to indicate your choice.

**For each referendum question, the following requirements must also be met:**

- The question must be given in at least 12 point font
- The question must be placed on the ballot in the prescribed order, as shown
- The question may be wrapped, if needed to fit it on the ballot

<p><b>QUESTION 2 - DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME</b></p> <p>Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?</p>	<p><b>YES</b> <input type="radio"/></p> <p><b>NO</b> <input type="radio"/></p>
