**Chestermere (Municipal) Crime Statistic Summary – January to September**

2022-10-04

*Chestermere (Municipal) – Highlights*

- **Break & Enters** are showing a 355.6% increase when compared to the same period in 2021 (January to September). There were 32 more actual occurrences (from 9 in 2021 to 41 in 2022).
- **Theft of Motor Vehicles** increased by 42.9% when compared to the same period in 2021 (January to September). There were 12 more actual occurrences (from 28 in 2021 to 40 in 2022).
- **Theft Under \$5,000** increased by 86.3% when compared to the same period in 2021 (January to September). There were 82 more actual occurrences (from 95 in 2021 to 177 in 2022).

*Chestermere (Municipal) – Criminal Code Offences Summary*

Crime Category	% Change 2021 – 2022 (January to September)
Total Persons Crime	48.4% Increase
Total Property Crime	53.9% Increase
Total Criminal Code	46.6% Increase

From January to September 2022, when compared to the same period in 2021, there have been:

- 61 more **Persons Crime** offences;
- 171 more **Property Crime** offences; and
- 248 more **Total Criminal Code** offences;

*Chestermere (Municipal) – September, 2022*

- There were 4 **Thefts of Motor Vehicles** in September: 0 cars, 2 trucks, 0 minivans, 0 SUVs, 1 motorcycles, 0 other types of vehicles, and 1 vehicles taken without consent.
- There were 2 **Break and Enters** in September: 0 businesses, 1 residences, 0 cottages/seasonal residences, 1 in some other type of location, and 0 unlawfully being in a dwelling house.
- There were a total of 3 **Provincial Roadside Suspensions** in September (3 alcohol related and 0 drug related). This brings the year-to-date total to 32 (30 alcohol related and 2 drug related).
- There were a total of 15 files with the **Spousal Abuse** survey code in September (September 2021: 0). This brings the year-to-date total to 116 (2021: 93).
- There were 161 files with **Victim Service Unit** referral scoring in Chestermere Municipal: 5 accepted, 35 declined, 12 proactive, 1 requested but not available, and 108 files with no victim.

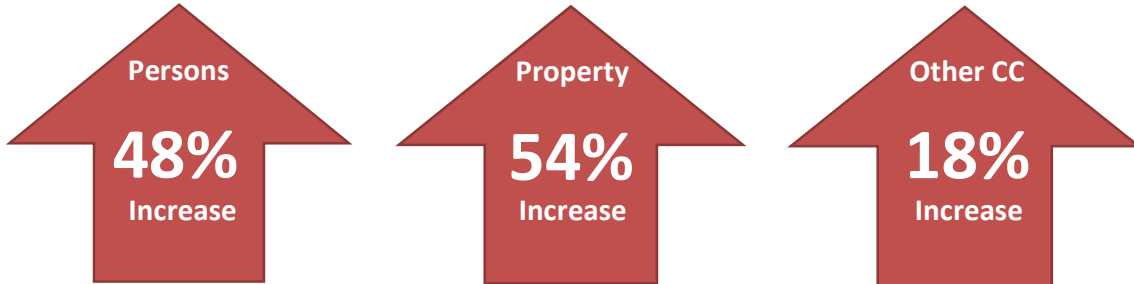

## Criminal Code Offences



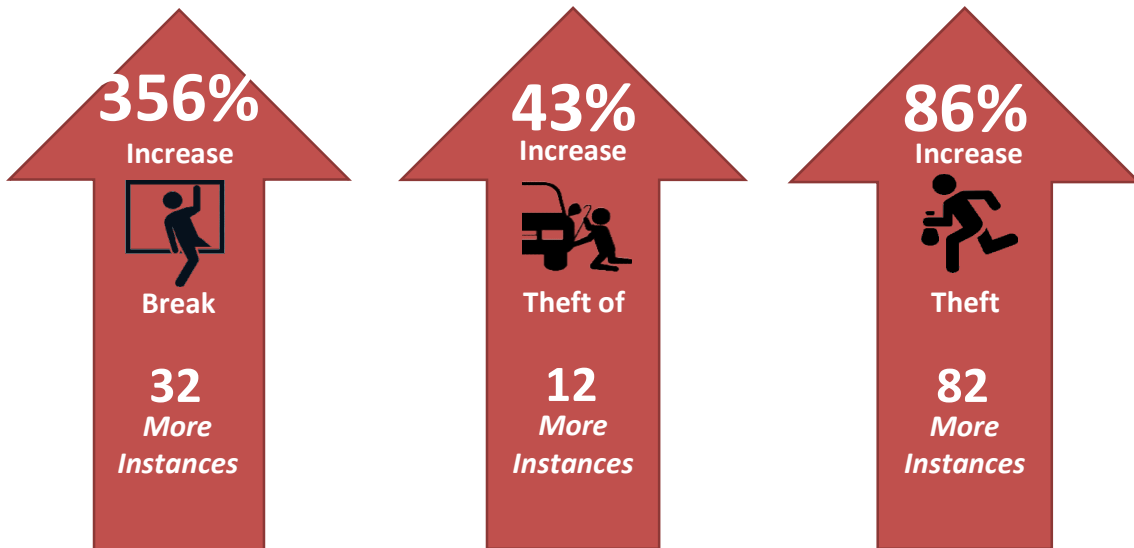
