

**TOWN OF CHESTERMERE
BYLAW 001-12**

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CHESTERMERE FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAVEL WITHIN THE PROPOSED SUBDIVISION OF LANDS PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

- WHEREAS** the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel;
- WHEREAS** application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed;
- WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Chestermere deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions, thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to same;
- WHEREAS** notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act; and
- WHEREAS** Council was petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by person(s) claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.
- NOWTHEREFORE** be it resolved that the Council of the Town of Chestermere in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

THAT PORTION OF ROAD ALLOWANCE WHICH LIES IN ROAD PLAN 7307 JK AND THE GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE BETWEEN THE N.E. 1/4, SEC 22, TWP 24, RGE 28, W.4TH M. AND THE N.W. ¼ SEC 23, TWP 24, RGE 28, W.4TH M. CONTAINING 0.345 HECTARES AS SHOWN IN SCHEDULE "A", EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS.
